

Nomination Guidelines

Early Career Development Award

A complete nomination for the Early Career Development Award must include:

- Whether your nominee has been informed of the nomination
- The nominee's contact information
- Reasons for the nomination

In separate documents uploaded as PDFs, please address these requirements:

- Provide a brief summary, biography, or resumé describing your candidate
- Provide evidence of your candidate's outstanding leadership relevant to the description of this award in the form of descriptive materials, testimonials, and/or other documentation (maximum five documents)

Your nomination will be evaluated based on the information you provide on:

- Patient care (providing patient-centred care, demonstrating clinical skill, exemplifying CanMEDS-FM Roles—Family Medicine Expert, Communicator)
- Citizenship (collaboration, contribution to community/society)
- Teaching and education (undergraduate teaching, supervision of residents, fellowships, continuing professional development, public education)
- Scholarship (scientific discovery, innovation, translation of knowledge to practice)
- Leadership and administration (medical or nonmedical organizations)

Letters of support from colleagues and the public may be included (maximum three letters).
