

Application Guidelines

Mimi Divinsky Award for History and Narrative in Family Medicine

A complete application for the Mimi Divinsky Award for History and Narrative in Family Medicine requires that you:

- Declare whether you are a:
 - Family physician CFPC member submitting a story in English
 - Family physician CFPC member submitting a story in French
 - Family medicine resident
 - Medical student
- Certify that patient confidentiality has been preserved in the story and identifiable biographical details have been changed
- Understand that your story will be included in the publicly available [Stories in Family Medicine](#) database; stories in the database are licensed under a [Creative Commons licence](#), under which you retain the copyright to your story and others have limited copying and distribution rights provided that you are credited
- Own the copyright to your story. In Canada an author automatically owns the copyright to their work, so unless you have assigned the copyright to another person or publisher your story is eligible. Stories in our database are licensed under a Creative Commons licence, under which authors retain the copyright to their stories and others have limited copying and distribution rights provided that the authors are credited.

Please upload your story as a separate PDF. Stories must be no more than 1,200 words in length.
