

# Application Guidelines

## Patient Education Grants for Family Medicine Residents

A complete application for the Patient Education Grants for Family Medicine Residents must include:

- Your current year of residency
- The name of your university
- The title of your project

In a separate document, please provide:

- A full description of your proposed project
- Your objectives and rationale for the need to create this project
- Your target audience
- A description of how will you disseminate the results of your project
- An explanation of how will you share any patient education tool you develop with the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) and the CFPC's Patient Education Committee

Please upload your complete submission as a PDF and adhere to these formatting requirements:

- Font – Arial or Times New Roman
- Font size – 12 point
- Margins – Standard one-inch margins
- Page restriction – 10 pages maximum

All sections must be completed. Submissions that exceed 10 pages will be truncated.
