

# Application Guidelines

## Research Grant for the Study of Communities Impacted by Health Disparities

A complete application for the Research Grant for the Study of Communities Impacted by Health Disparities must include:

- The name of the principal investigator
- The total number of co-investigators
- The co-investigators' information (names and occupations)
- The project title
- Your project's duration (start and end dates)
- Evidence of ethical approval; this is required if your study involves humans or animals as subjects
- The project's clinical trial registry and registration number (if applicable)
- Payment details (Payments will be made in the name of the principal investigator. In some cases payments can be redirected to a registered charity. If funding is awarded, will payment be redirected to a third party? If so, please provide the name and charitable registration number.)

In a separate document, please provide:

- A summary of your project (maximum 300 words; must be suitable for a public audience)
- A funding proposal (a full proposal for the project is required along with a description of how the funds will be spent)

Please upload your complete submission as a PDF and adhere to these formatting requirements:

- Font – Arial or Times New Roman
- Font size – 12 point
- Margins – Standard one-inch margins
- Page restriction – 10 pages maximum

All sections must be completed. Submissions that exceed 10 pages will be truncated.
