## Nomination Guidelines

## Family Medicine Resident Awards for Scholarly Achievement

A complete nomination for the Family Medicine Resident Awards for Scholarly Achievement must include:

- The total number of nominees who contributed to the project
- Contact information for each nominee, including their university and program year
- The project title

As separate documents uploaded as PDFs, please provide:

- A brief CV describing each nominee
- An abstract describing the research project or a full manuscript (a full manuscript is required to be considered for the Nadine St-Pierre Award)
- A reflective piece if the nominee is to be considered for the Nadine St-Pierre Award; candidates should submit a summary, in-depth reflection, or a review of the literature or original research on the subject of their choice

All nominations submitted on behalf of francophone family medicine residents will be forwarded to the Quebec College of Family Physicians for the selection of the Nadine St-Pierre Award, which recognizes the best scholarly work of an outstanding francophone family medicine resident in Canada. To be considered for the Nadine St-Pierre Award the nomination must include a full manuscript in French and a reflective piece from the author(s).
