

# Nomination Guidelines

## Family Medicine Resident Scholarship

A complete nomination for the Family Medicine Resident Leadership Awards must include:

- The nominee's contact information
- The name of the nominee's university

In separate documents uploaded as PDFs, please provide:

- A brief CV describing your nominee (maximum four pages)
- Two letters of support from faculty members

Letters of support are an important component of the selection process for the Val Rachlis Leadership in Family Medicine Award and should include sufficient information about your candidate's skills as a leader and orator to support this nomination. Candidates will be scored based on academic accomplishments related to family medicine, leadership qualities, service to a community of need, oral presentation skills, and special achievements during medical school and/or residency. Please provide as much detail as possible.

In another separate document, please provide evidence for one or more of the following:

- Leadership activities during residency/leadership qualities (beyond departmental and program activities, such as participation in organized family medicine, the College of Family Physicians of Canada's Section of Residents, or Resident Doctors of Canada)
- Academic achievements related to family medicine (e.g., publications)
- Research achievements
- Unique achievements or exceptional activities in medical school or residency
- Service to a community of need (involvement in supporting vulnerable populations, such as rural, Indigenous, LGBTQ+, addiction/mental health, inner city, etc.)
