It's the REF's 20th Anniversary Year!

The year was 1994. Dr Brian Hennan, Dr Marco Terwiel, and Dr Reg Perkin signed the Industry Canada application for "letters patent" to create the Research and Education Foundation (REF) of the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC). Their vision was of a charity dedicated solely to supporting research and education initiatives carried out by family doctors on behalf of their patients.

Their wish to serve the future of family medicine has been realized through the hundreds of award recipients who have had a significant impact on patient care in large and small communities across Canada. The CFPC's Honours and Awards program, funded through the REF, offers awards, grants, and scholarships to members from the time they are medical students considering a career in family medicine, and following them through the many possible paths their career may take them, including areas such as global health, mental health, care of the disabled, rural medicine, and many more.

Each year more than \$500,000 is disbursed to our members to pursue research and education, and another \$250,000 funds family medicine projects within the CFPC. In 2012, a record \$1,000,000 in donations was received. At the time of the writing of this newsletter, the REF surpassed \$10,000,000 in cumulative contributions over two decades. Each year, we continue to add new awards to expand our portfolio to better serve the needs and goals of CFPC members.

Another significant event this year will be the 10th anniversary of Walk for the Docs, which has become a popular activity at Family Medicine Forum. Please join us for the 2014 Walk for the Docs Saturday, November 15th at 7 am in Quebec City to celebrate the continued growth of the REF and the future of family medicine.
