

FMF 2017 a fundraising success!

We are thrilled to share the results of our fundraising efforts during Family Medicine Forum (FMF) 2017 in Montreal, Quebec. Over the course of four days we successfully raised \$28,590 through a variety of events and with the help of numerous College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) staff and members. Here is the official breakdown:

- \$3,090 Section of Researchers Dinner (Family Medicine Research fund)

New walk, same champions

After 12 years of the Walk for the Docs of Tomorrow, the FAFM decided to rebrand the annual event, held in conjunction with FMF, and redirect the funds raised to advance family medicine globally. The shift to Walk With the Docs — Advancing Family Medicine Globally resulted in a boost in fundraising, extended friendraising, and increased awareness of the Besrour Centre. A priority initiative for the FAFM, the Besrour Centre's vision is to lead the way in creating a world where no one is left behind when it comes to accessing high-quality family medicine.

In the early morning hours of Saturday, November 11, 2017, more than 100 participants laced up and walked through downtown Montreal

to show their support for family medicine as the foundation of health systems around the world. Together we raised \$12,685! Once again, members of the Family Medicine Interest Group (FMIG) from Memorial University of Newfoundland proved themselves as skilled philanthropists, raising \$4,200 and coming in first place (for the fifth Walk in a row!) in our annual FMIG contest. As a result, they took home the Walk trophy, team jackets to add to their growing collection, \$1,000 to put toward a FMIG initiative, and bragging rights.
