Nomination Guidelines

Environmental Health Award

A complete nomination for the Environmental Health Award must include:

- Whether your nominee has been informed of the nomination
- The nominee's contact information
- Reasons for the nomination

In separate documents uploaded as PDFs, please address these requirements:

- A brief summary, biography, or résumé describing your candidate
- Evidence of your candidate's outstanding commitment to and leadership in environmental health in the form of descriptive materials, achievements in environmental issues, testimonials, and/ or other documentation (maximum five documents)

Your nomination will be evaluated based on the information you provide about:

- Breadth of involvement in health and environment issues
- Length of commitment to the issue(s)
- Leadership both within the profession and within the wider community
- Policy work
- Education of the profession and the wider community
- Leadership and administration (medical or non-medical organizations)
- Research and publications
- Involvement with environmental boards
- Membership on environmental committees

Letters of support from colleagues and the public may be included (maximum three letters).
