Nomination Guidelines

Family Medicine Researcher of the Year

Nomination process:

Any two members of the College of Family Physicians of Canada may submit a name for consideration.

Each nomination must be accompanied by:

- Letter of support from each nominator that succinctly describes the nominee's contribution and achievements in family medicine research consistent with the criteria outlined in the award description
- Two additional testimonial letters may be submitted (each limited to one page), which specifically address the selection criteria of the award
- Background materials including published articles or documents, and tools or other resources that document the nominee's contribution to family medicine research
- Current and comprehensive career curriculum vitae that includes the nominee's research activities demonstrating their contribution to the discipline of family medicine

Selection criteria:

The assessment of a nominee's contribution to family medicine research will be based on the following criteria:

- Originality/innovation
- Relevance to family medicine
- Rigour and quality of research
- Influence on family medicine research
- Leadership role

- Evidence of impact on family medicine practice, policy, or education
